



Dr Márcio Kiuchi, MD, MSc, Ph.D., ISHRF, FESC, FEHRA, FHFA, is a graduate of University Estácio de Sá School of Medicine, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil (2003) and certified as Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) in the same year by the Brazilian Medical Council. He trained in Cardiology at Federal Fluminense University, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil (2009), and in Arrhythmias and Pacing at the Lagoa Federal Hospital, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil (2014). The

Brazilian Medical Council certified him as Specialist in both fields.
